Background

This professional development module is one of four professional development areas that the Massachusetts Department of Education has established for building the competencies of content and classroom teachers to work with Limited English Proficient students in Massachusetts public and charter schools. Description

This training is based on a curriculum developed by the Center for Applied Linguistics, and is designed to prepare secondary-level subject matter teachers to utilize sheltered strategies in order to make the content more comprehensible to English Language Learners. It meets the requirements of Category 2 (Sheltered Content Instruction). MATSOL will be delivering this training for the FLLAC Collaborative. A pre-course information packet will be sent to all registered participants in advance of the course. This course involves 24 contact hours. The remaining work adding up to the required 30-40 hours done outside of class is in the form of readings and assignments and in applying concepts in the teacher's classroom. A 3-unit graduate credit option is available through Cambridge College. Participants will be able to register for credit on Day 2 of the course.

Intended Participants

The MA DOE has indicated that any classroom with even one ELL is considered an SEI classroom by law. Secondary classroom/content teachers of record (grade 6-12) who do have or who may in the future have ELLs placed in their classrooms should take this course.
